PPSCC Holds Annual Exhibit Online

Pastel Painters Society of Cape Cod (PPSCC) will hold its 24th annual For Pastels Only on Cape Cod national exhibition online from June 20 to July 12. Thirty-one artists will receive their awards virtually at a Zoom opening reception on June 29 at 5 p.m.

For Pastels Only on Cape Cod features paintings by 100 internationally-recognized contemporary artists with a wide range of artistic styles and subjects, including coastal scenes, still life, and figurative work. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, the reception and show will be

held online for the first time. More than \$6,000 in cash and merchandise will be awarded to 31 artists by co-chairs Janet Schwartz and Tamara Amoroso during the Zoom opening reception. For more information, including the Zoom link to the reception, visit ppsc.org/exhibitions/#FPO2020.

All 100 works of art are available for purchase. Forty percent of all sale proceeds from the show will be donated to charity, split between Cape Cod and the Islands Major Crisis Relief Fund and the Cultural Center of Cape Cod.

CCF Issues COVID-19 Relief Grants

The Cape Cod Foundation has deployed an additional \$130,000 in grants from the Massachusetts COVID-19 Relief Fund. The grants are being made to 10 nonprofit organizations selected by The Cape Cod Foundation that provide critical services to Cape Cod residents impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. To date, the Foundation has received \$350,000 from the Massachusetts COVID-19 Relief Fund to deploy on Cape Cod.

Receiving grants are Cape Cod Children's Place, Cape Cod Community College Educational Foundation, Catholic Social Services of Fall River, Friends of the Bourne Council on Aging, Inc./ Bourne Friends Food Pantry, Harwich Ecumenical Council for the Homeless, Homeless Prevention Council, Salvation

Army Hyannis, Sandwich Food Pantry, Soup Kitchen in Provincetown and Yarmouth Food Pantry.

To date, The Cape Cod Foundation has raised just under \$1 million for its newly-created Strategic Emergency Response Fund from discretionary resources, individual donors, corporate partners, and foundations. It has now distributed a total of \$580,000 in grants to 29 nonprofit organizations serving the Cape Cod region.

On March 10, 2020 in response to the COVID-19 emergency, Governor Baker declared a State of Emergency. On April 3, 2020, the Massachusetts Legislature passed the "Act of 2020," to address the challenges faced by municipal authorities resulting from COVID-19. The Act of 2020 suspended statutory and regulatory deadlines applicable to the Conservation Commission. Section 17(b) of the Act of 2020 provides that a board or commission may schedule and reschedule a hearing one or more times "by declaration of its chair," without the need for approval by a quorum of the board. Pursuant to declarations of the Chair of the Chatham Conservation Commission, hearing dates for all applications will be scheduled in the order in which they are received, and applicants will be notified of those hearing dates in writing prior to the scheduled hearing.
